The Oregon Clinic Accelerates Network, Improves Patient Care with Time Warner Telecom's Metro Ethernet Service

The Oregon Clinic is a multi-specialty medical practice with locations throughout the metropolitan Portland area

Time Warner Telecom is delivering Ethernet services from 10 Mbps to 500 Mbps to support the clinic's network
